Pembroke – Robert Clifford Jarvis, 76, of Pembroke, passed away peacefully on Friday, July 24, 2020 at the Catholic Medical Center in Manchester after an extended illness with his wife by his side. 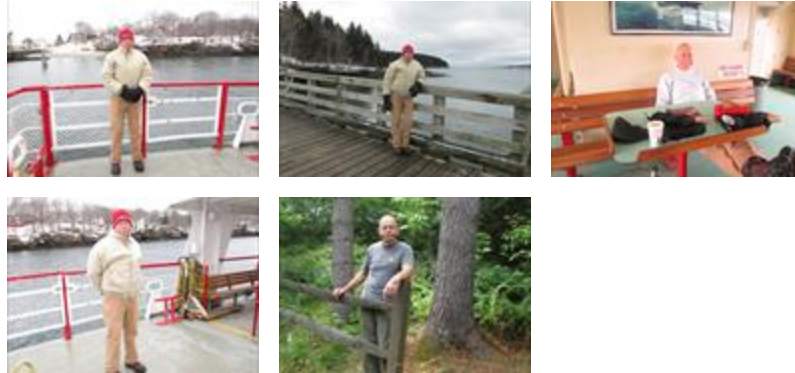
