



## Robert E. Linscott Sr.

Amesbury – Robert E. Linscott, Sr., 69, of Amesbury, passed peacefully to be with Christ on April 26, 2014 with his family lovingly by his side.

He was born October 9, 1944 in Portsmouth, NH a son of the late Joseph H. and Thelma (Seavey) Linscott.

He graduated from Winnicunnet High School in Hampton, worked for Parsons Electric in NH, and went on to be employed at Vaughn Corporation in Salisbury as a foreman in charge of maintenance retiring with nearly 20 years of service. He was also known as “Mr. Fix It” or a Jack of all trades --having the ability to solve mechanical, plumbing, and electrical problems. He could fix anything.
