



Robert E. Moaratty Sr.

December 12, 1934 - January 4, 2024

Hampton- Robert E. Moaratty Sr., 89, of Hampton, passed away peacefully at Exeter Hospital, surrounded by his loving family, on Thursday, January 4, 2024, following a period of declining health. He shared 68 years of marriage with his loving wife Nancy (Smith) at the time of his passing.

Born in Amesbury, MA on December 12, 1934, to the late Eugene and Ruth (Morton) Moaratty, Bob was raised in Hampton and attended Hampton public schools, graduating from Hampton Academy in 1952. He was a master plumber at Palmer & Sicard plumbing and heating contractors for 45 years and was also a master electrician. Bob's well-deserved retirement was in 2000.

An outdoorsman, he enjoyed his camp on Milton Three ponds, in Milton, NH where a boat ride for an ice cream at Everett's cove or a fishing trip with his family made his day. One of his favorite pastimes was deer hunting in Nottingham with his father-in-law. Best of all, Bob loved his family. He will be remembered for being a generous man, who would give anyone the shirt off his back.

Left to cherish his memory are his wife Nancy and sons Miachel and Jay Moaratty both of Exeter, Jeffrey Moaratty of Mirror Lake, and Peter Moaratty of Greenland, as well as brothers Richard and Donald Moaratty. He also leaves

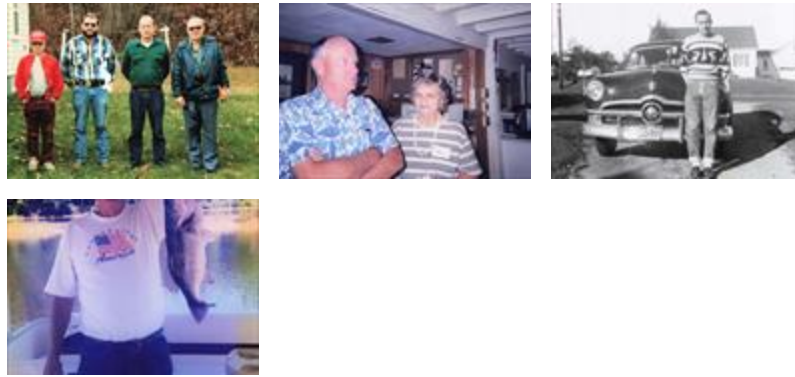
