“ To Bob, Janet and Family - We were so sorry to hear about Robert and you have our deepest sympathies for your loss.

*I first met Robert in 1998 when he called looking for some information about a product that we both provided services for. Shortly after this first meeting we worked on a variety of projects for several years and we probably talked at least once a day for several years while we developed and tested a variety of products. He was clever and smart and had a knack for problem solving that made my life as a product designer much easier. I pretty much knew if we had a problem then one of us would figure out a solution.*

*I actually met Robert for the first time, face to face, in 2002 when my family and I, fresh from a family camp in the finger lakes, joined Robert to meet with Gary Bordonaro at Cornell University. Later in the summer of the same year Robert kindly put us up in his home when my family and I were driving and vacationing in the Southwest. He was generous with my kids and they enjoyed their time with him (and his pool).*

*In 2003 Robert and I were working again with Gary at Cornell and the power went out in most of the eastern seaboard. My wife was with me and our kids were back home in Ottawa, alone for the first time. Robert somehow was the only guy with working phone service and managed to get us into probably the only open restaurant somewhere near a marina. He managed to get us connected with our kids back home which eased our anxiety (typical - first time kids alone, major power outage and talk, much exaggerated, of rioting in the streets).*

*He was resourceful and ever concerned about other people's comfort. He was a kind and thoughtful host. He had an ability to 'schmooze' with strangers and customers that I always envied. We stayed in touch after he moved on to different things and I visited him whenever I was in Arizona and he always took time to show me around and make sure I was fed and enjoying myself. He took time*

*to show friends of mine around while they were considering retirement plans in Arizona. He always managed to call me at least once a month or so, since we stopped working on joint projects, with ideas for new things or just to talk about my family and what we were up to. He even managed to find jobs with clients for my daughter Devon to do and she surely appreciated the money while in University. We are going to miss him.*
