Bobbi faced her illness with extraordinary strength, grace, and her signature sense of humor that did not waver. Born on April 17, 1942, in Rockford, Illinois, Bobbi was the cherished daughter of Robert and Mary Miller (Tassoni) and big sister to her brother Jeffrey Miller.

Bobbi was the devoted wife to Bob, just 2 weeks shy of 62 years. Her joy only grew with the arrival of her grandchildren, Maddy (Giese) Farens and Jack Giese, and her great grandson, Cade Farens, all of whom brought her immeasurable pride and happiness. Bobbi's children, grandchildren and great grandson were her proudest accomplishments. One of Bobbi's most cherished memories with her family was her trip to Bellagio, Italy to attend her Granddaughter Madeline's wedding. She radiated pure joy and insisted on greeting the guests at

breakfast even while staying until the party ended each night.

A lifelong athlete with a passion for competition and camaraderie, Bobbi loved playing softball, tennis and golf that brought her joy and lifelong friendships. She enjoyed playing in a golf league and going on golfing trips with the golfing girls. Bobbi loved making dessert for the UMPL group for the many gatherings. She brought that same energy and spirit to her family life. Bobbi's legacy lives on through the lives she touched with her strength, warmth and Zest for life.
