



Rocky Gauron

October 10, 1950 - December 11, 2016

Seabrook – Gregory A. “Rocky” Gauron, 66, of Seabrook and a former longtime resident of Hampton, passed away peacefully at Massachusetts General Hospital on Sunday, December 11, 2016 surrounded by his devoted family.

He was born in Exeter on October 10, 1950, a son of the late Alfred and Alice (Semacko) Gauron.

Rocky was raised in Hampton and graduated from Winnacunnet High School with the Class of 1968. Starting at an early age, Rocky worked the family fishing fleet from Hampton Harbor. He started as a mate, then Captain and eventually owner of Al Gauron’s Deep Sea Fishing and Whale Watching. He loved fishing and being on the ocean and passed this trait on to his children and grandchildren. Rocky had a fantastic sense of humor and well known for his “engine room voice.”

He is survived by his beloved wife of over 43 years, Denise (Doucette) Gauron of Seabrook; his children, Angel Eaton and her husband, Charles of South Hampton, April Nicoll and her husband, Michael of Seabrook and Gregory Gauron and his fiancée Sarah Hughes of Hampton Beach. He also leaves his brothers, Alfred “Ricky” Gauron and his wife Geri, of Key West, FL, Mark “Randy” Gauron and his wife Patricia of Hampton and Edmund “Ronnie”

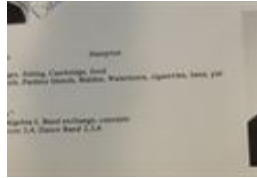
