Hampton – Roger R. Lemire, 87, died March 5th, 2025.

He was born in Manchester, NH, on May 20th, 1937, the son of the late Roland Lemire and Violet (LaPlante) of Manchester, NH.

Roger graduated from Manchester West High School and attended St. Anslem's College in Manchester.

Later, he enlisted in the United States Naval Reserves. He was a Master electrician working for his father, Roland Lemire, in Manchester, and later held management positions at Ralph Pill Electric Supply and Mass Gas & Electric before owning and operating his own electrical service company (ABC Electric) of Hampton.
