



## Ronald E. Flodman

May 5, 1937 - January 28, 2016

Exeter – Ronald E. Flodman, 78, of Exeter, passed away peacefully at his home on Thursday, January 28, 2016 after an extended illness. His beloved family was at his bedside.

He was born in Worcester, MA on May 5, 1937, a son of the late Everett Flodman and Ruth (Greenslit) Brown.

Ron was raised and educated in Worcester and graduated from Wachusett Regional High School with the Class of 1955. He went on to earn his Bachelor of Arts Degree in Chemistry from Clark University of Worcester and his Masters of Business Administration Degree from American International College of Springfield.
