Kittery, ME - Ronald A Fowler, Sr., 77, of Kittery, died peacefully at home on Sunday Feb 12, 2017 after a lengthy battle with lung cancer.

He was born September 7, 1939, in Portsmouth NH, a son of Alice (Olson) Fowler of North Hampton NH and the late Caleb N Fowler, Jr.

A proud veteran, Ronald served in the US Army from 1957-1966. He had been employed at Bailey Corp. of Seabrook, NH for 10 years and for Betty's Dream Foundation of Portsmouth, NH for over 20 years before retiring to care for his loving wife during her battle with cancer.

He was a devoted son, husband, father and friend. Ronald was a man who went the extra mile to help others reach their destination. In 2008 he became an artist specializing in New England landscapes and lighthouses. With every stroke of the brush he put his heart and soul into his work. One of his favorite quotes was "One man's junk is another man's treasure". His all-time favorite hymn was The Old Rugged Cross. He had a heart of gold and infectious laugh that brought joy to all who knew and loved him.

He is survived by his mom, Alice Fowler of North Hampton, NH, his son Ronald A Fowler, Jr. of Concord, NH and his two daughters, Janah Fowler Trent and her husband Alex, of Kittery Point and Kathy Fowler Parenteau and

her husband Dennis, of Macclenny, FL; 10 grandchildren; seven great-grandchildren and his brother, Carl Fowler of Prospect.

In addition to his wife, he was predeceased by his father Caleb N. Fowler, Jr. and his sister Marion Fowler Rose.

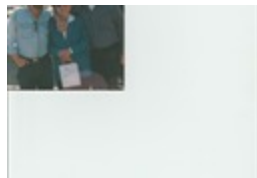

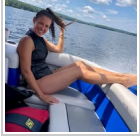
