



## Roy T. Mattucci

March 30, 1933 - August 10, 2024

North Hampton - Roy T. Mattucci, 91, of North Hampton, passed away peacefully on Saturday, August 10, 2024 surrounded by family.

He was born in Jersey City, NJ on March 30, 1933 a son of the late Arthur B. and Mabel (Smith) Mattucci. Roy's father was born in Lucca, Italy and came to the United States in 1902. Raised in Ridgewood, NJ, Roy graduated from Blair Academy with the Class of 1951 and received his B.A. in history from Dartmouth College in 1955.

Following graduation, Roy proudly served in the United States Army with the 63rd Field Artillery Battalion in Korea from 1956 to 1957. Until his retirement, Roy's career was in the construction industry, having been a principal with several local firms. Prior to moving to New Hampshire in 1969, he worked for Frank Briscoe Construction Co. and the Glendale Construction Co. in New Jersey.

Roy was a talented athlete. An avid Red Sox fan, he was a season ticket holder for many years. He also enjoyed scuba diving, boating, tennis, photography and attending local jazz venues. Roy was a long-time member of the New Castle Yacht Club, Seacoast Tennis Club and local photography clubs.

Surviving family members include his wife of 69 years, Doris (Colleary) Mattucci of North Hampton whom he married on June 18, 1955; his children, Lynn Mattucci of Arlington, VA, Roy T. Mattucci Jr. of North Hampton and grandchildren, Monica and Michael Mattucci of Exeter. In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by his siblings, Donald J. Mattucci, of Deerfield Beach, Fla and Joan Macfarlan Lindsey, Ponte Vedra, Fla.
