Hampton - Ruth (Crockett) Ells was deceased April 21, 2016 at the age of 89 years.

Ruth was born on December 15, 1926 in Dover-Foxcroft, ME to the late Harry and Stella (Hutchins) Crockett. She graduated from Foxcroft Academy and became a telephone operator for Bell Telephone working in Portland, ME as the servicemen returned from World War II.

She married Gordon N. Ells in 1947 and because of his work with the American Water Works Company, resided in various locations in Maine, New Hampshire, Massachusetts and New Jersey. The family returned to Hampton in 1971 where she resided until moving to assisted living at Poplin Way in Fremont.

After being a stay-at-home mother, she returned to work as a teacher's aide at Centre School and later as the school nurse at Marston School both in Hampton. Ruth was a member of the Hampton Lions Club.

In addition to her husband Gordon, she was predeceased by her daughter, Elizabeth and her son, Robert.
