Hampton Beach, NH – Sandra Jean Kubik, 77, of Hampton Beach, passed away peacefully after a brief illness on Monday, May 31, 2021 at the Exeter Hospital. Sandra was born on September 14, 1943 in Beverly, MA, a daughter of the late John and Viola F. (Libbey) Snow.
