



## Scott Alan Bean

Hampton - Scott Alan Bean, age 65, passed away peacefully at Portsmouth Regional Hospital on September 1, 2025. Scott, a NH native born in Manchester, was a longtime resident of Hampton NH and graduated from Winnacunnet High School in 1978. An accomplished athlete throughout his youth, Scott lettered in both basketball and soccer and continued to support local youth in sports through coaching.

Scott earned his bachelor's degree at the University of New Hampshire's Whittemore School of Business and was a lieutenant in the U.S. Coast Guard serving at duty stations in NJ, VA, and NH. Scott was a NH business leader, family leader and owner of Bean Insurance Agency which he managed with his brothers, Phil and Bob and nephew Robbie. Beyond his business successes, Scott was committed to community service and philanthropy, including serving as president of the Hampton Chamber of Commerce and a being an active member of the rotary.

A passionate sports enthusiast, Scott found every opportunity to cheer on his Boston teams. His encyclopedic knowledge of his favorite team, the Celtics, was unrivaled. He served as social director for WRFL for 35 years. Scott enjoyed travel, whether it was a fishing trip to the Maine Allagash or beach time in the Caribbean. World travel included visits to Cape Town, South Africa where he visited Robben Island and Juneau, Alaska to fish for salmon. He

shared his love of the outdoors with his large circle of friends and would never pass on the opportunity for an adventure. He always had his pets by his side and his dog Dewey was a constant loyal companion.

Scott is survived by his wife Chris, who has been his biggest support and source of joy for 41 years. He leaves his brothers, Richard, Douglas, Philip, and Robert. Scott was a super uncle and great uncle to more than thirty beloved nieces and nephews, many of whom saw him as a second father. Scott never left a human in need and helped others quietly without any expectation of recognition. Scott's wit, kindness, generosity and unwavering love for his family and friends will be remembered always.
