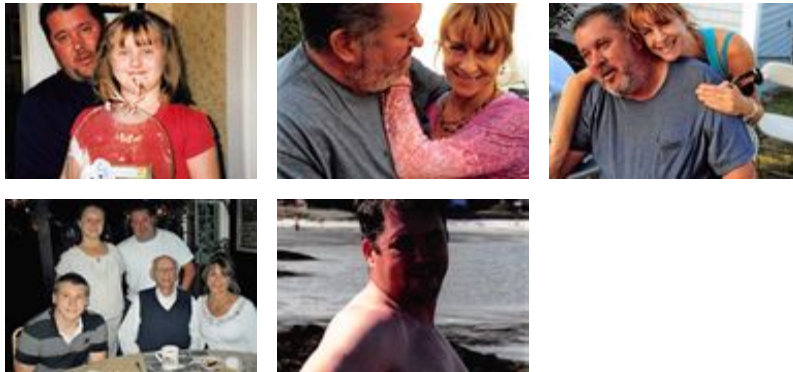

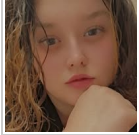

“*Scotty was an outstanding human. I and my family will be eternally grateful of him. When I broke out on my own and began my own plumbing business Scotty looked out for me. He would pass my contact info along to his customers who needed plumbing work and always follow up with a phone call and it usually went something like this "Hey kid, I gave your number to Mrs. Smith, shes a good one, I only give your number to the good ones ya know. Call her back if you can't take the call right away, but make sure you call her shes a real good lady. Ok kid, stay busy you'll do well, youre a good boy." Those referrals in the early days were instrumental to building my business. It kept food on the table and the lights on. If business was a little slow in the early years he would have me help out with a water heater or a quick HVAC repair just to have a little money. During those days I would take on any and every call that came in, sometimes I would be in over my head and I'd call Scotty. More often then not he would talk me through some tough trouble shooting and if I couldn't figure it out on the phone he would come help. Not do the job but coach me through. Down through the bulkhead Scotty would come, "Hey kid, what kind of trouble are you getting into now". I learned so much and he wanted nothing in return. I would have to hunt him down at the north beach or Logans and buy him a drink or two which he would refuse and buy me a drink or two in return. He was kind, helping a young tradesman out just for the sake of just being good. I'll miss him dearly. Thank you Scotty.*
