



Sidney L. "Sid" Brayton

January 5, 1950 - September 21, 2013

Kershaw, SC - Sidney L. "Sid" Brayton, 63, of Norcross, GA, formerly of North Hampton, passed away on Sept 21, 2013 of a heart attack while racing at Carolina Motorsports Park in Kershaw, SC.

Sid was born in Exeter on January 5, 1950, a son of the late Kenneth and Virginia (Dyer) Brayton.

Sid was raised in North Hampton and graduated from Winnacunnet High School and UNH with a degree in Electrical Engineering. Sid started his career working for General Electric in Iowa and was transferred to several locations including IL, CT and NC. He changed companies in the early 1990s, going to work for Siemens in NC and retired from Siemens earlier this year in Norcross.

Sid was active in his church, Snellville Christian Church, where he taught Sunday School. He belonged to the Peachtree Miata Club and did extensive travels in his Miata. He bought an RV for his retirement and did a dream trip this summer from Georgia to the west coast and back to NH. He traveled mostly back roads and sent regular emails titled, Where in the world is Sid now, with interesting anecdotes and photos to a large following of friends and family. Sid loved auto racing both as a participant and a spectator.

He is survived by his daughters, Laura Brayton of Hoboken, NJ and Gail and her husband James Perrella of Milford, CT; his granddaughter Ava Skye Perrella; his brother Kenneth and his wife Dina of Arlington, VA; his sister Beverly and her husband Bill O'Hara of Tilton, NH and his three nieces and one nephew.
