North Hampton – Stephen H. Gehrman, 58, of North Hampton, died unexpectedly, Thursday, November 16, 2017 at Massachusetts General Hospital in Boston, MA.

He was born in Haverhill, MA, May 5, 1959 the son of the late Melville and Patricia (Tarpley) Gehrman.

Steve spent his early years in Plaistow and attended Winnacunnet High School. He was employed as a master diesel mechanic for the former Mel's Truck Sales in North Hampton for 19 years. In 1994 he founded Steve's Truck & Auto of North Hampton and the Portsmouth Naval Shipyard became one of his largest accounts for their heavy equipment repair.
