



## Steven L. Pelletier

Hampton- Steven L. Pelletier, 61, of Hampton passed away peacefully on Saturday, June 1, 2024 at Portsmouth Regional Hospital. He was born in Newburyport, MA on February 21, 1963, son of Norman Pelletier and Evelyn (Smith) McAuley.

Steven grew up in Newburyport and graduated from Whittier Regional Vocational Technical High School in Haverhill, MA in 1981. He had a love for welding and fabrication, and he was the one you called if you needed something fixed that someone said couldn't be fixed. In 2018, he received an award from the Shriners Hospital Aleppo Cycle Unit for fixing and retrofitting a competition trailer used for their bikes that nobody else could fix. If you needed help, he would be there in a flash. He was a very giving and caring person throughout his entire life that got great joy in helping others. Even at the end he gave the gift of life to others by being an organ donor. Truly a selfless person.

Steven loved outdoor activities, especially fishing. He was also a giant animal lover. Most of all, he loved spending time with his cat Theo.

Steven is survived by his father Norman Pelletier of Salisbury, his mother and stepfather Evelyn and Frank McAuley, fiancé Dale Lanagan of Hampton, his brothers Norman Jr. and his wife Donna of Hampton, Brian Pelletier of

Henderson, NV, nephew Simon Storm of Newmarket, and his good friend Anthony Amato of Newburyport.
