Rochester- Steven Francis Sarson, 57, of Rochester and formally of Hampton, passed away peacefully on Sunday, January 27, 2019 after a brief illness. He was born October 25, 1961 at the Air Force Hospital in Molesworth, England while his father was assigned with the United States Air Force at RAF Chelveston. He was a son of the late Dennis J. and Joan D. (Jerome) Sarson.

The family moved to North Hampton in 1965 and he attended Sacred Heart School and graduated from Winnacunnet high with Class of 1979. Steven enlisted in the United States Army shortly after graduation and was assigned to an outfit in Germany. He returned home and worked for the former Digital Equipment Corporation, Compaq and Hewlett- Packard. He was also the racing director at Yankee Greyhound in Seabrook for a brief time.

Steven was a quiet, hard-working man and a loyal friend. He loved shooting darts and was a Double "A" Shooter and had served as President of the Seacoast Dart Association.
