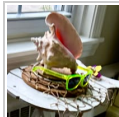

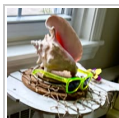

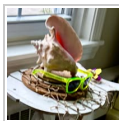
Hurricane Carol on Mill Road: we all were there for safety until a tree fell on the house.
