



Theodore "Ted" Trask Robinson

September 10, 1930 - December 27, 2024

Hampton - Theodore Trask "Ted" Robinson, of Hampton, New Hampshire died peacefully at home on Friday evening, Dec. 27, 2024, after a courageous battle with cancer with his family by his side.

He was born Sept. 10, 1930, in Boston, Mass., a son of the late Frederick R. and Gertrude M. (Pierce) Robinson.

Ted was a Korean War veteran serving with the US Air Force. After serving his country he moved to the seacoast area. He began his career in metal fabrication and succeeded his father at the former Arc Way Welding in North Hampton, New Hampshire, retiring after 50 years of service.

He was a member of Hampton's American Legion Post 35, a former member of the Kittery Yacht Club, Hampton River Boat Club, 100 Club of Portsmouth, Military Preservation Association, and the Military Vehicle Club.

He shared 48 years of his life with his beloved companion, the late Jill (Palmeira) Arsenault Robinson and her five children.

Survivors include his son, Theodore "Tom" Robinson, and his wife Cleo of Venice, Florida, one stepson, William J. Arsenault of Santa Monica, California, four stepdaughters, Marie R. Absmeier and husband Jim of San Jose, California, Lorraine C. Arsenault of Gorham, Maine, Donna M. Pennel and husband Butch of Bedford, Pennsylvania, Debra J. Henderson and husband

Richard of Stratham, New Hampshire, Ted's brother, Richard "Dick" Robinson and his wife Gaylee of Hampton Falls, New Hampshire, twelve grandchildren, ten great grandchildren, and one great-great grandchild.
