North Hampton – Theodore M. “Ted” Turchan, 65, of North Hampton, died Friday, May 16, 2014 at Portsmouth Regional Hospital with loving family by his bedside after an extended battle with cancer.

Ted was born July 5, 1948 in Bridgeport, CT, the son of the late Walter and Helen (Banas) Turchan. He was raised in Stratford, CT. He graduated from Stratford High and Norwalk Technical College. He married his high school sweetheart and beloved wife of over 43 years, Eileen (Adamchak) Turchan in 1970 and the couple settled in Milford, CT. They moved to North Hampton in the early 1980s after purchasing Marcoda Kennels of North Hampton. Ted was very active in North Hampton where he was a member of the Zoning Board and the Town Planning Board.
