



## Thomas H. Bilodeau

February 3, 1943 - May 6, 2013

Hampton, NH – Thomas H. Bilodeau, 70, died Monday, May 6, 2013 at Clipper Harbor of Portsmouth.

Mr. Bilodeau was born in Nashua, NH February 3, 1943, the son of the late Henry F. Bilodeau and Ethel (Watkins) Bilodeau Nadeau. He never knew his dad, who died in The Netherlands during WWII and was raised by his mother and adoptive father, Norman Nadeau. Raised in Nashua, he was a graduate of Nashua High School and attended the University of New Hampshire.

He was a Vietnam era veteran serving with the US Air Force.

Mr. Bilodeau was a manufacturer's representative selling doors and hardware for Bullard Associates, a company which he later owned.

He had a passion for the outdoors, hunting and fishing and was a long time member and president emeritus of the Hampton Rod and Gun Club. He was also a pilot, owning his own plane and enjoyed flying model airplanes.

Family members include his wife of 24 years, Jacqueline L. Bilodeau of Hampton, NH; a son Kevin Bilodeau and wife, Bernadette and their children, Henry and Merrick of Boxford, MA; three daughters, Pamela King and husband, Michael and their son, Joshua of Derry, NH, Kelly Long and
