



Thomas E. Byrne Jr.

November 21, 1959 - July 26, 2015

Newmarket – Thomas E. Byrne, Jr., 55, of Newmarket and formerly of Hampton, passed away suddenly at his home on Sunday, July 26, 2015.

Tom was born November 21, 1959 at the Naval Shipyard Hospital in Kittery, ME, the son of Thomas E. Byrne, Sr. of Hampton and the late Dorothy F. (Paone) Byrne.

Being part of an Air Force family, Tom moved many times as a child. His family eventually relocated to Hampton when his Dad was transferred to Pease Air Force Base. He graduated from Winnacunnet High School with the Class of 1977 and went on to earn his Bachelor's Degree from UNH.

Tom married the love of his life, Helen Hauser-Byrne in 1990, and they settled in Hampton to raise their family before moving to Newmarket. He led a fulfilling career in construction as a skilled finish carpenter and contractor for many years, and was most recently employed by the Dana Dowling Company of Stratham. Tom was a hard-working, intelligent and organized man who loved to read and learn new things. He was a creative soul who was always up for new challenges and loved home projects. He was very witty and possessed an extraordinary sense of humor. He was highly regarded by his peers as a kind, decent and honest man. Tom was a diehard Red Sox fan, and loved to talk sports with anyone who would listen. He was very

competitive and enjoyed ping pong, cards, chess and billiards. In 1997, he led a billiards team that represented the state of NH to a national competition in Las Vegas. Above all else, Tom was a devoted husband and a loving father. He will be sadly missed by his family and his close friends.

In addition to his father, Tom is survived by Helen, his loving wife of nearly 25 years, and his son, Joshua, both of Newmarket; his sisters, Deborah Gardner and her husband, Jeff of Manchester, Brenda Richards and her husband, Howard of Laconia and Cynthia Conant and her husband, Todd of Oak Ridge, TN. He also leaves many nieces, nephews, cousins and friends.
