Hampton – Thomas R. Frolo, 88, of Hampton, passed away peacefully on Friday, November 4, 2022, with his family by his side.

He was born September 1, 1934, in Monessen, PA son of the late Antonio and Mary (Mongelluzzo) Frolo. Raised in Monessen he graduated from Monessen High School with the Class of 1953 and later Pennsylvania State University where he studied engineering. 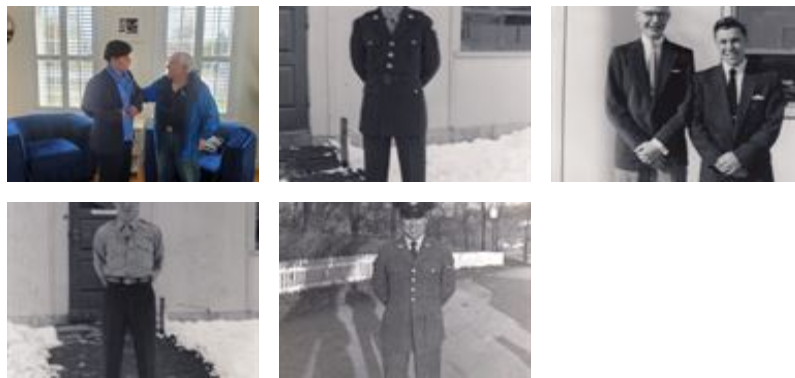
