

## Thomas R. Ryerson

May 17, 1948 - May 7, 2014

Portsmouth - Thomas R. Ryerson, 65, died unexpectedly on Wednesday, May 7, 2014 at Portsmouth Hospital. Tom's life partner and love of 30 years Barbara Lang and his daughter Catherine Pagano were by his bedside.

Tom was born May 17, 1948 in Queens, New York, a son of the late John and Anna E. (McGuire) Ryerson, and spent his youth in Queens and on Long Island, New York.

Tom moved to New Hampshire and worked for Perini Power Company and United Engineers at the Seabrook Nuclear Power Plant as a pipefitter in the early 1980's. In 1984, he started his property manager career at Harbour Place with Seaboard Development Corp. and continued on at Harbour Place, working with the Seaboard Whalen Company. He was currently employed by CP Management in Exeter as Director of Facilities overseeing a large inventory of properties throughout New Hampshire including Harbour Place in Portsmouth. 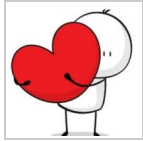
