November 12, 1930 - May 24, 2014

Hampton, NH – Thomas Sharpe, III, 83, of Hampton, died Saturday, May 24, 2014 surrounded by his family at Hyder Family Hospice House, Dover.

He was born November 12, 1930 in Salem the son of the late Thomas Sharpe, Jr. and Eunice (Lake) Azziz.

Tom was raised in Salem, where he served 25 years as a police officer retiring in 1985. He later worked as a roofer with his sons at T. Sharpe & Sons Roofing.

Tom was an avid hunter, outdoorsman and a member of the Spacetown Beagle Cub in Raymond as well as several other Beagle Clubs. In his younger years he worked as a farmer and was a Golden Gloves boxer. He also was a longtime member of the Spicket Lodge #85 F&AM Masonic Lodge in Salem and Bektash Temple Shrine in Concord.

He shared 37 years of marriage with his wife MaryAnn (Pacheco) Sharpe of Hampton.

In addition to his wife, family members include his sons, Thomas D. Sharpe and his wife Sherryl of Windham, Stephen Sharpe and Rosalie Riley of Salem, David Sharpe of Salem, James Sharpe of Pittsburgh, Ryan Sharpe

and his wife Amanda of Hampton; daughters, Linda Burke and her husband Kevin of Salem, Donna Kelley and her husband Kevin of St. Cloud, FL, Billie-Jo Sharpe and Michael Demers of Hampton; three sisters, Eleanor Girard of Salem, Virginia Ball of Townsend, Mass., Barbara Belanger of Salem; several grandchildren, great grandchildren, great great grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.

In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by his son Robert E. Sharpe.

“ *MaryAnn and Family,*

Many of these notes contain fond memories of times spent with your family at the camp. I feel I must share my own. When I first met Mr. Sharpe, and I will always refer to Tommy as Mr. Sharpe as he is the father of one of my dearest friends, Donna, I was afraid of him. He was a large, booming man in a police uniform and I was a young teenager. We always knew we had to fly straight in town because if Mr. Sharpe found out there would be hell to pay. Our group of friends were pretty good kids and we never got caught! Sort of.

My next encounter was much more pleasant. I was invited for a snowmobiling weekend at the camp. Now, as a naive, native New Hampshire resident, my idea of a weekend away was at a fancy hotel next to Santa's Village or Clark's Trading Post. Boy was I in for a treat. My first surprise was parking the trucks with the snowmobiles in tow at the end of what looked like a long, tree-lined dirt road. Only it was covered with about five feet of snow. I was equally surprised to learn that the only way to the camp was by snowmobile. Sweet. I'm not shy on a sled. My dad, Johnny Castricone, took us out regularly up and down Rt. 111 before it was paved. (Yup, I'm that old). In a short while, everything was packed up and off we rode. I don't recall how long the trek took us. I was just enjoying the ride.

I won't describe every aspect of the camp, although there were a few new experiences here I didn't expect. That place was cold. But once Mr. Sharpe got that old stove cooking I felt better. There was a bunk area for many people to sleep in. Again, fancy-hotel-girl! I thought, OK, this can be fun. I'm used to sleepovers at friends homes. But you usually don't sleep, right? Then there was the outhouse. Go ahead. Laugh. I'm over it.

The whole weekend went on as planned; snowmobiling, card playing and good food. Mr. Sharpe sure knew his way around that stove. I distinctly remember his brief but memorable lesson on how

to season an iron skillet. Funny what things stick with you. But I can tell you that I was blown away with the view. How lucky I felt to hang out here for a whole weekend with great friends.

I've visited the camp a few other times since my virgin visit. Although they were not with Mr. Sharpe. This is the part about good kids never getting caught. Sort of. It was one of those weekends with a hand full of close friends. No boys, just girlfriends. No Mr. Sharpe. And we didn't ask permission. This visit was in the middle of the summer when mosquitoes are the size of hummingbirds. That didn't stop our fun. The sun was shining and the lake was refreshing. We would sail around at dusk in the canoe. I distinctly remember it was my first time hearing a true echo of my voice. It sounded so clear bouncing off the hills. It was thrilling.

So, yes we did get caught by a friend of the family. I apologize for forgetting his name but he had an amazing log home with mountain views. From what I remember, this guy was big and booming as well. We were sent home with our tails between our legs but also great memories.

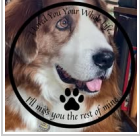

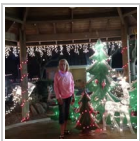
