Vicki was an avid bridge player, movie enthusiast and enjoyed the most challenging puzzles. She loved the arts and enjoyed spending the day at any museum or the theater. She found inspiration and peace there. Over the years she enjoyed creating her own art with needle point, crochet, knitting, cross stitch, painting, stained glass as well as pottery. She always had a smile on and was there to lend an ear if needed to anyone.
