Seabrook – Victor J. "Chachi" Porro, 79, a 30-year resident of Seabrook, passed away peacefully on Monday, October 20, 2025.

He was born in Haverhill, MA, on May 25, 1946, the son of the late Victor B. and Helen (Senter) Porro. Raised in Haverhill, Victor enlisted in the United States Marine Corps in 1963 at the age of 17 and proudly served multiple tours in Vietnam.

After returning home from the service, Victor started his career at the Portsmouth Naval Shipyard in Portsmouth, NH, as a shipwright. He dedicated 39 years to his craft before retiring in 2016.

Known to his family and friends as "Chachi," he was a member of the VFW and American Legion. Chachi enjoyed karaoke, playing KENO, and most of all, sharing laughs and making memories with his family and many friends.

He is survived by his children, Victor J. Porro and his wife Kaylee of Monroe, NY, and Tanya Porro and her partner Brian Boyette of Umatilla, FL. Also survived by his grandchildren, Victor J. IV, Mikeithen, Elizabeth and her husband Cam, and Jacob. He also leaves behind 3 great grandchildren and his sister, Sharon Porro.
