



## Virginia M. Manning

November 17, 1926 - March 17, 2014

Hampton – Virginia M. Manning, 87, of Hampton, formerly of Stoneham, Mass., died Monday, March 17, 2014 at Concord Hospital.

She was born in Winchester, Mass., November 17, 1926, the daughter of the late William L. and M. Christine (Devaney) Mellen.

Virginia was raised in Stoneham and after high school graduated from the Katherine Gibbs School in Boston. She worked as an executive secretary at the Copley Plaza Hotel for years before marrying the love of her life, the late Thomas J. Manning, Jr., and settling in Stoneham to raise their family.

Virginia found time to be a member of the Stoneham Garden Club and was quite proud of winning numerous awards for her striking floral arrangements. She was an avid, to say the least, Red Sox fan and enjoyed watching them play up until the time of her death. She loved animals and was always rescuing another dog or cat from the shelters. The couple moved to Hampton in the 1980s after Thomas retired where she was an active communicant at Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal Church.
