



## Virginia R. Marsh

September 30, 1919 - November 28, 2013

Rye, NH – Virginia R. Marsh, 94, known to her friends as Ginny and longtime resident of North Hampton, died peacefully on Thursday, November 28, 2013 at Sanctuary Care, Rye.

She was born September 30, 1919 in Plymouth, Mass., a daughter of the late Augustino and Teresa (Alessi) Semprini.

Ginny was raised in Portsmouth in the Puddle Dock/Strawberry Banke neighborhood and was a graduate of Portsmouth High School with the Class of 1938 and later from beauty school where she became a hair stylist.

Working as a beautician for several years she later became Dean of Students at the Portsmouth Beauty College. She also worked as Director of Food Services for the North Hampton Elementary School.

Virginia was a communicant of St. Theresa Church, in Rye Beach and a member of the North Hampton Woman's Club. Ginny enjoyed line dancing, clogging, doing puzzles, playing bingo and being outside.

She was the wife of the late Henry W. Marsh who predeceased her in 1985.

Virginia is survived by her dedicated son Henry and his wife Phyllis of North

Hampton; loving daughter Barbara Greitzer and husband David, also of North Hampton; four grandchildren, Tory and Jamie Marsh, Steve and Elissa Short and great granddaughter Ayanna Short; two sisters, Eva Marconi of Portsmouth, and Margie Tuttle of Kittery, ME and sister in law, Eileen Semprini, as well as several nieces and nephews.

In addition to her parents and husband, Virginia was predeceased by her sisters, Mary Gagnon and Alice Semprini; four brothers; Primo, Ralph, Lino and Mario Semprini, and granddaughter Carrie Marsh.

A mass of Christian burial will be celebrated at 11 AM, Tuesday, December 3, 2013 in St. Theresa Church, Rye Beach. Burial will follow in the Center Cemetery, North Hampton.
