



## Virginia M. Menihane

November 30, 1931 - May 6, 2022

Seabrook Beach - Virginia Mary Menihane, 90, long-time resident of Seabrook Beach, New Hampshire, passed away extraordinarily peacefully on Friday, May 6, 2022 at Bridges by Epoch Memory Care Assisted Living in Westford, Massachusetts.

She is predeceased by her oldest brother, Edward James Collins, formerly of Woburn, MA and sister-in-law Minnie Collins, formerly of Chelmsford, MA.

She was a Communicant of Saint Elizabeth of Hungary Catholic Church in Seabrook Beach, New Hampshire and regularly bore the gifts of bread and wine to Our Lord's altar each Saturday at 5:30pm mass.
