



## Lt. Col. Wallace S. Berg Sr.

October 5, 1924 - July 31, 2023

Greenland – Wallace Seward Berg, Sr., Lt. Col, USAF (Ret.), 98 years old, of Greenland, passed away peacefully at his home on Monday, July 31, 2023, with his Florette, his beloved wife of 60 years, at his bedside.

Wally was born in Indianapolis, IN on October 5, 1924, a son of the late Goldie (Landis) Raye. After graduation from San Diego High School, he enlisted in the Army Air Corps and was in training to become a pilot. When World War II ended, he transitioned to the United States Air Force, earned his Bachelors Degree from San Diego State College, and was commissioned as a 2nd Lieutenant where he served as an Armament Officer for the next 32 years. While honorably serving his country, Wally earned his Masters Degree in Political Science from Golden Gate University. In 1976, Lieutenant Colonel Berg retired from the Air Force as an Aerospace Munitions Staff Officer.

Retirement was not in Wally's vocabulary. He never slowed down and his entrepreneur spirit took off. He was a skilled woodworker and cabinet maker and opened Minuteman Furniture in Portsmouth. He also started a wood importing business and got into tea importing for a time as well. In addition to his other accomplishments, in his 90's, Wally was granted three patents by the US Patent and Trademark Office,

his daughter, Georgia Koontz of Oceanside, CA and is predeceased by his son, Wallace S. Berg, Jr. of Alexandria, VA. He also leaves his grandchildren, W. 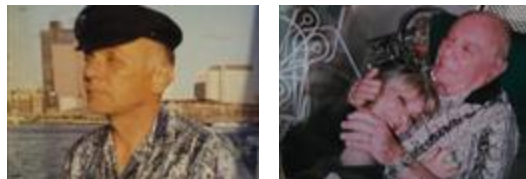
