



## Walter S. Chawziuk

September 22, 1927 - March 12, 2016

Exeter NH - Walter S. Chawziuk, 88, of Exeter, died Saturday, March 12, 2016 surrounded by his loving family.

Born in Lowell, MA on September 22, 1927, he was the son of Adam and Stanislaw (Giedyman) Chawziuk. He attended Lowell High School, Tilton Academy, Indiana State University and graduated with a degree in Business Administration from Boston University.

A veteran of World War 2, Mr. Chawziuk proudly served as a sergeant in the U.S. Marine Corps., stationed on Midway Island.

He co-owned Valentine & Chawziuk of Boston MA, a company that represented textile manufacturers. Previously he was the advertising manager for Bon Marche in Lowell, MA.

A member of Vesper Country Club, in Tyngsboro, MA for many years, Walter loved playing golf. Winning the Club Championship there was one of his proudest accomplishments. He was also a lifelong, passionate fan of ALL the New England sports teams, never missing any of the action on TV or in the news. Walter was a devoutly religious man. He was a former communicant of St. Michael's Parish in Lowell, MA and most recently, St. Theresa Parish in Rye Beach, NH.

He is survived and will be deeply missed by his wife of 56 years, Joan T. 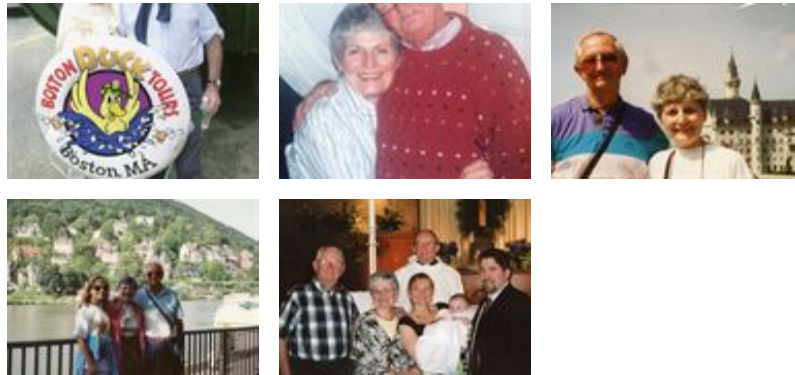
