North Hampton – Walter S. Kowalczyk, 90, of North Hampton, died Wednesday, July 1, 2020 at Portsmouth Regional Hospital after a period of failing health. He was born July 21, 1929 in New York, NY a son of the late Adolf and Frances (Lewandoski) Kowalczyk.

He graduated from Merryhill High School in 1947 and got drafted into the US Army in February of 1951 and served to January 1953. He worked in the aluminum industry in New York.
