Rye, NH – Walter S. Peek, 93, of Rye, died peacefully Thursday, June 23, 2016 at his home surrounded by loving family.

He was born in Portsmouth, August 18, 1922 a son of the late Walter J. and Etta (Bennett) Peek.

Walter was a lifelong resident of Rye who graduated from Portsmouth High School with the Class of 1941.

Mr. Peek served in the United States Army from 1942 to 1945, seeing action in the European Theater all the way from Normandy to Gera, Germany, during which he received a Silver Star amongst other medals. After his time in the Army he returned home and went to work at the Portsmouth Naval Shipyard as an inside machinist, before retiring in 1978.

Walter was a lifetime member of the VFW and the Grange.

Family members include his wife of 35 years Josephine (Fortin) Peek of Rye; sons, Walter S. Peek Jr. of Lincoln, ME, Benjamin F. Peek also of Lincoln, James H. Peek of Hampton Falls, Gordon L.
