Seabrook - Warner B. Knowles, 76, passed peacefully at his son's home surrounded by family on February 4, 2022. He was born in Newburyport, MA February 22, 1945 to the late Lester Knowles and the late Lillian (Beckman) Knowles. He was raised in Seabrook, and resided there for most of his life.

Warner was employed by the town of Seabrook for 40 years beginning as a laborer and became superintendent for both the water and sewer departments before retiring in 2012. He was instrumental in providing utilities to Seabrook's residents. He met his friend of over 50 years, Matthew "Skip" Lewis, while working at the Navy Yard in Kittery, ME. They founded the Shiloh Christian Church in 1979 in Warner's living room that is still active to this day.

Friends and family will remember him as an avid fisherman and hunter. In the spring he fished at Frost Pond in Maine with Skip, fall was for deer hunting, and summers were spent fishing for striped bass off the coast with his son, Brian.
