



## Warner Jay Morse

April 6, 1962 - January 16, 2019

Hampton – Warner Jay Morse, 56, of Hampton and formerly of Lynnfield, MA, passed away suddenly on Wednesday, January 16, 2018 at the Portsmouth Regional Hospital.

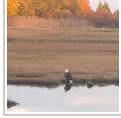
