Seabrook, NH - Mr. William Joseph Brooks, known to all as "Bill", age 78 of Seabrook NH, died unexpectedly on August 13, 2020, in Salisbury, MA.

He was born in Dedham MA, on April 4th 1942, son of the late Alice C. Sears Brooks and brother to Rosalie Priore and husband Ron of Westwood and Kathleen Mangion of Haverhill.
