



William "Billy" Roland Giovagnoli

Rotonda West, FL- William "Billy" Roland Giovagnoli, age 76, of Rotonda West, Florida, passed away peacefully at his home in North Hampton Beach on July 2, 2025, surrounded by his loving family.

Born on November 3, 1948, in Manchester, New Hampshire, Billy was the son of the late John A. and Laurette F. (Laverdiere) Giovagnoli. He was raised on the family "Giovagnoli Pig Farm", as the locals called it, where he learned the value of hard work and resilience—qualities that would define his life. Billy attended Manchester Memorial High School and went on to serve his country honorably in the United States Army during the Vietnam War.
