Salisbury, MA- William George Hawe Jr., 75, of Salisbury, MA passed away peacefully in his sleep the morning of April 24, 2023, while at home in the company of his daughters.

William was a graduate of Cathedral High School in Dorchester, MA, in 1965 and Wentworth Institute of Technology in 1967 with a degree in Machine Process Technology. His career in engineering spanned 50 years holding various positions at MIT, Brooker Lab, EG&G and completing his career at Excelitas (formerly Perkin Elmer). His unique experience allowed him to work in a consulting position upon his retirement, and he would also happily “consult” often about his extensive engineering knowledge and previous experiences, with anyone that would lend an ear.

William is survived by his children: son William Motroni of Tewksbury, MA, along with his wife Nicole and children Molli and Tyler; daughter Katherine Goscinski of Costa Mesa, CA, and her husband Andrew; and daughter Maureen Hawe of Salisbury, MA. He is also survived by his longtime significant other Maureen Shea of Amesbury, MA. William is also survived by his sister, Maureen Jordan-Salveti of Marshfield, MA, and her three sons Hal, Christopher, and Jonathan and their families.

William was very selective but the things he loved, he loved fiercely. He very much enjoyed boating on the Merrimac River, cruising down the beach on his Harley, and simply loving where he lived, enjoying the peace and quiet living in his home on a cul-de-sac overlooking the backyard panoramic marsh views. He was most “himself” at home, either peacefully alone or enjoying the company of Shea, or other family and friends visiting, while sharing a cocktail in the afternoon sun on the back deck, sunporch, or living room.

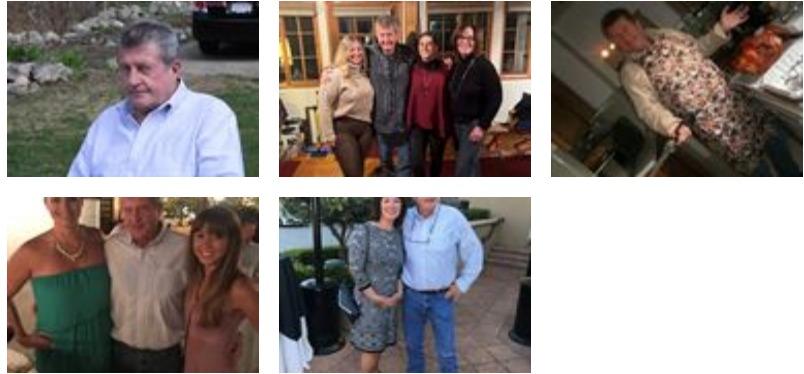
