



## William J. Ladrie

November 25, 1924 - May 31, 2015

Rye, NH – William J. Ladrie, 90, of Rye, died peacefully, May 31, 2015 at his home surrounded by his loving family.

He was born in Portsmouth November 25, 1924 a son of the late Victor Ladrie and Mary (Nault) Molnar.

Raised in Portsmouth by his mother and step father Mike Molnar after his birth father died at a young age. He attended local schools and worked at the Portsmouth Naval Shipyard before joining the Navy and proudly serving our country during WWII. During his time in the service William served onboard the heavy cruiser USS Canberra where he was deployed 7 times during the Asiatic-Pacific Theatre.

After his time in the service William returned home and started his career as a Meter Man for the former Public Service of New Hampshire, retiring after 41 years. During this time he also worked 9 years at the town of Rye Sewer Commission.

William loved spending time with his grandchildren, Riding his boat and spending time at Mousam Lake in Shapleigh, ME. He also was a member of the VFW Post 168 of Portsmouth.

Family members include his wife of 64 years Dorothy (Hopkins) Ladrie of Rye; sons, Alan Ladrie of Rye, Mark Ladrie and his wife Roberta of Dover; grandchildren, Tonya Ladrie of Dover and Brian Ladrie of Auburn, ME; brother Lewis Ladrie of Portsmouth; sister Evelyn Marconi of Portsmouth and many nieces and nephews.

In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by his brother Victor and sisters, Angie, Irene, Rose, Margret, Helen, Doris, Florence and Cornine.
