Hampton – William A. “Billy” Morgan, 67, of Hampton, died Sunday, December 12, 2021 at Oceanside Skilled Nursing & Rehabilitation after a period of failing health. He was born January 31, 1954 in the Bronx borough of NY, a son of the late Harvey R. and Carol L. (Kleinitz) Morgan.

Billy graduated from Seaford High School in Long Island, NY with the Class of 1972, attended New York Institute of Technology and graduated from the Academy of Aeronautics in Queens, NY.

He worked as an aircraft mechanic beginning with Eastern Airlines, and later the Trump Shuttle and retired from US Airways in 2013.
