Hampton – Winifred T. “Winnie” Kearney, 97, of Hampton, formerly of Arlington, MA, died Friday, March 18, 2022 at her home after a period of failing health. She was born in Charlestown, MA June 12, 1924, the daughter of the late James and Winifred (Hannon) Kelly.
